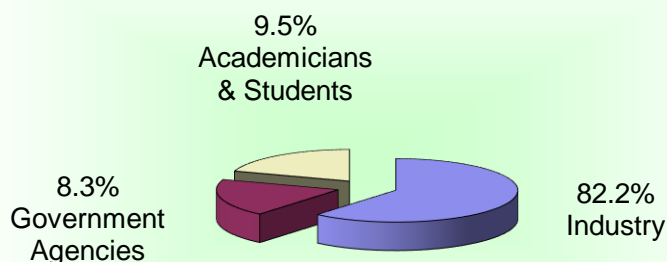
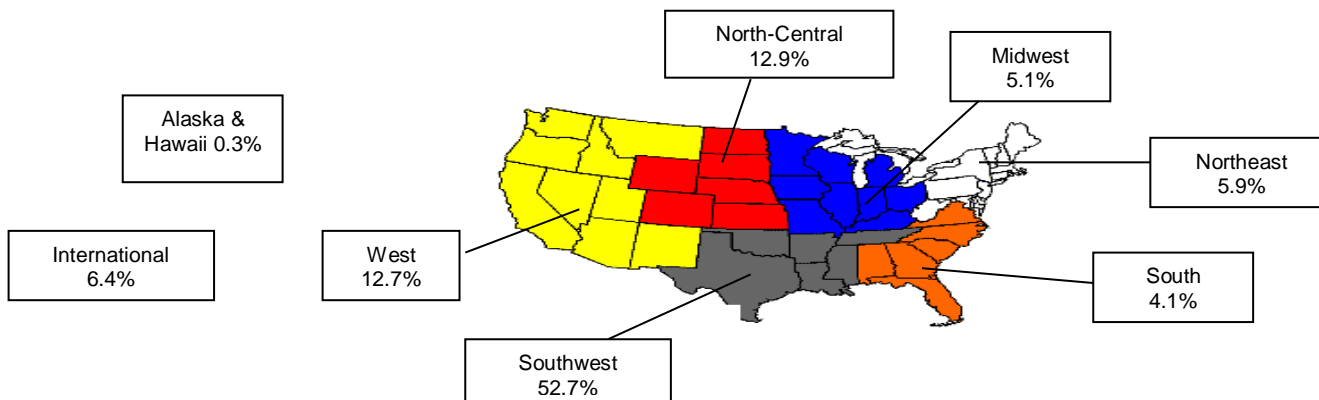


Chart represents 10 yr average:
